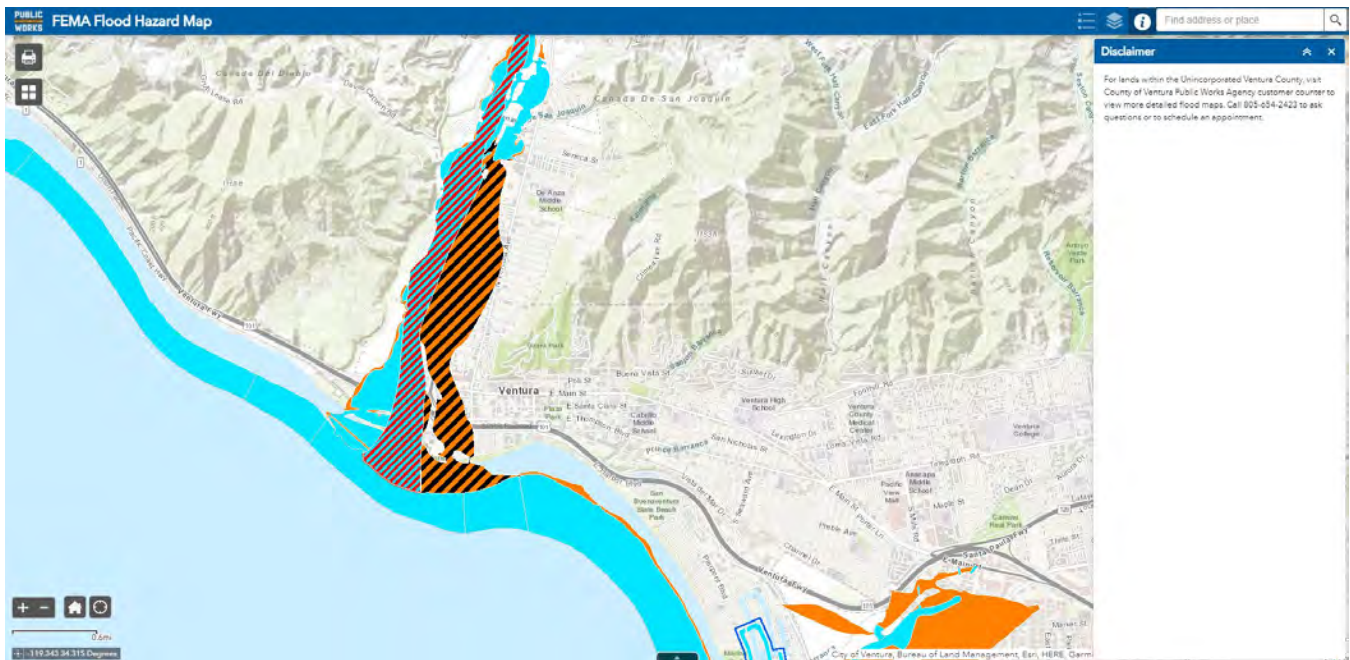
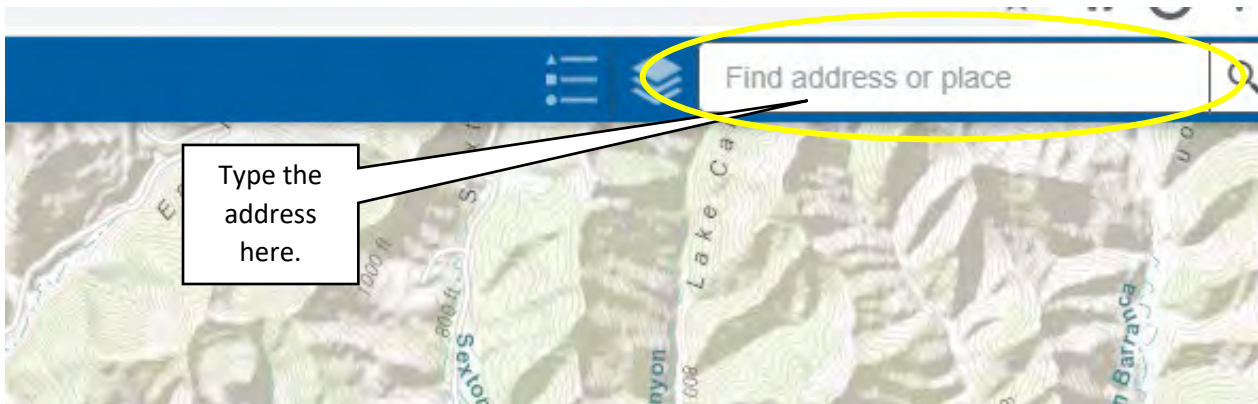


# How to Lookup Your Address in the Online Map Viewer

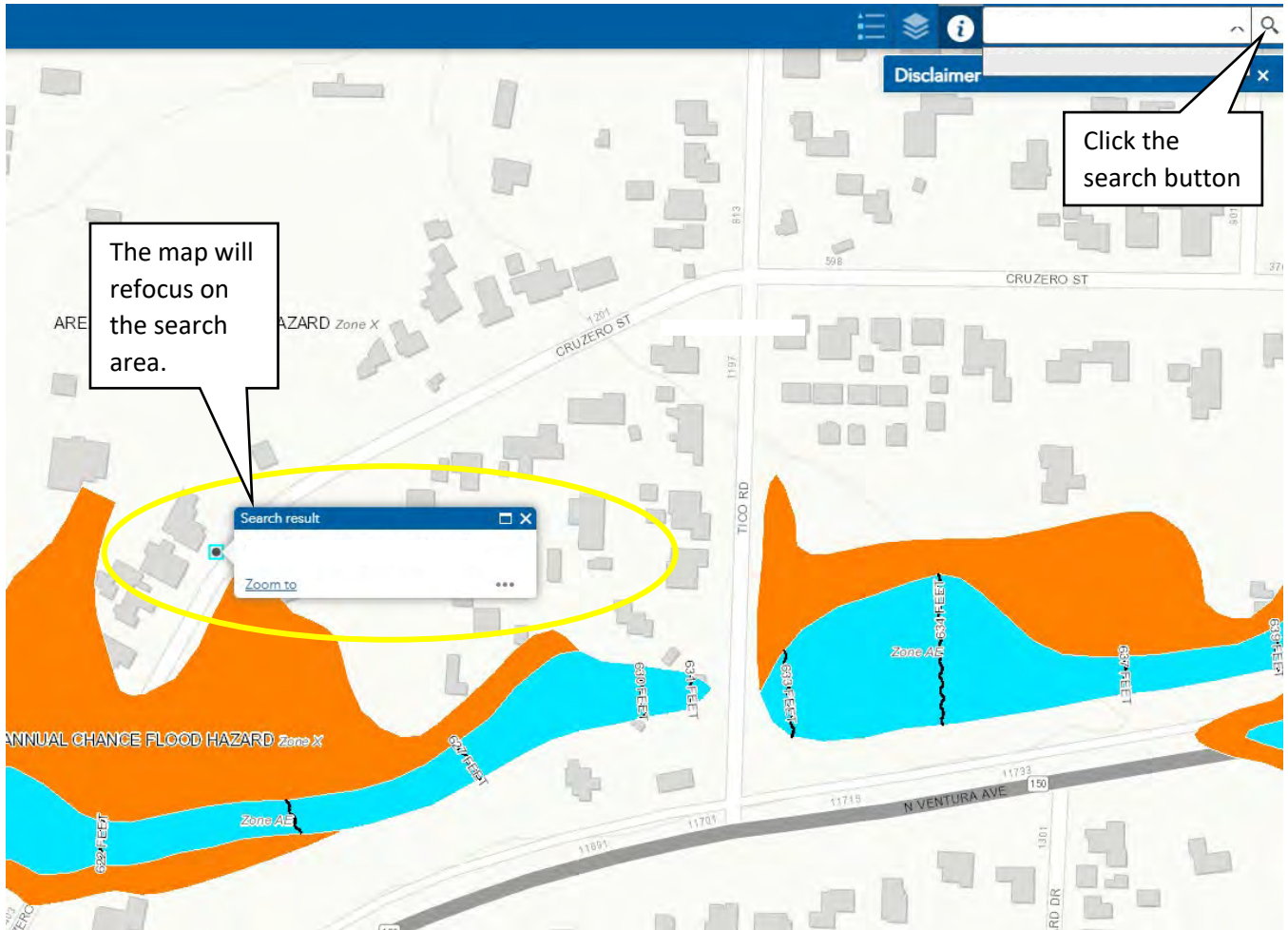
1. Go to <https://vcwatershed.net/maps/flood-hazard-map/>



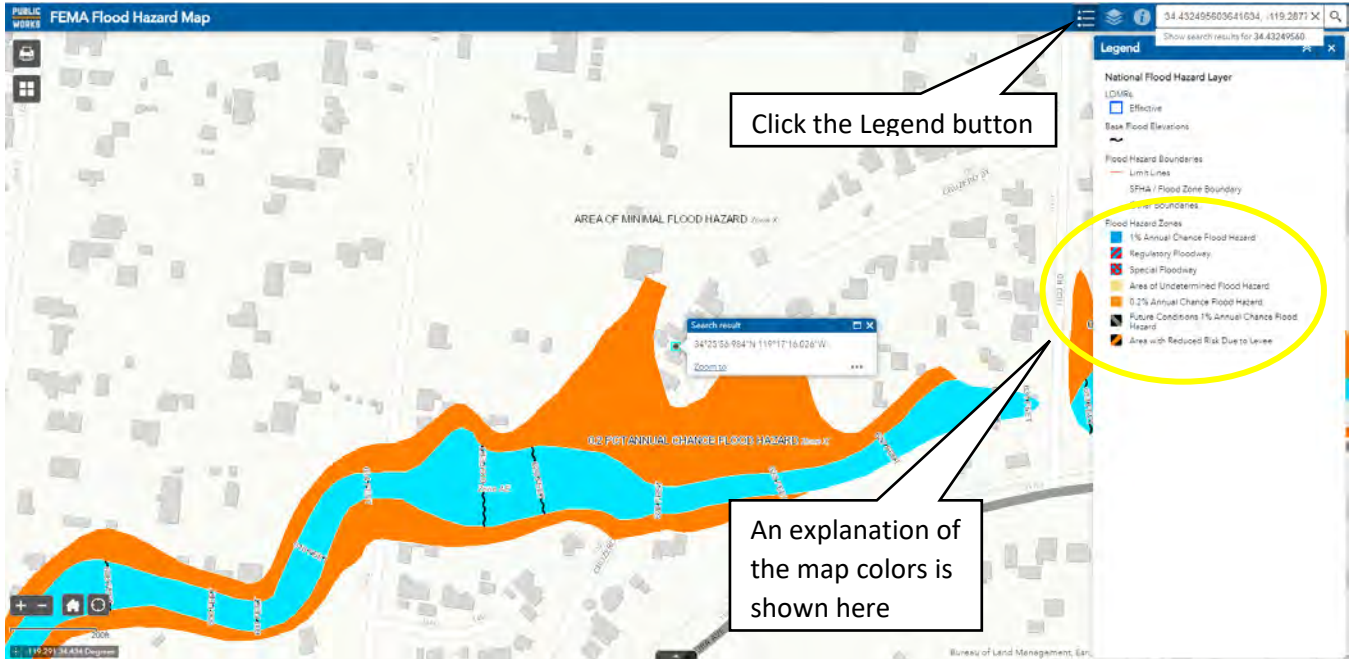
2. Type in the address of the property you are looking up on the upper right corner.



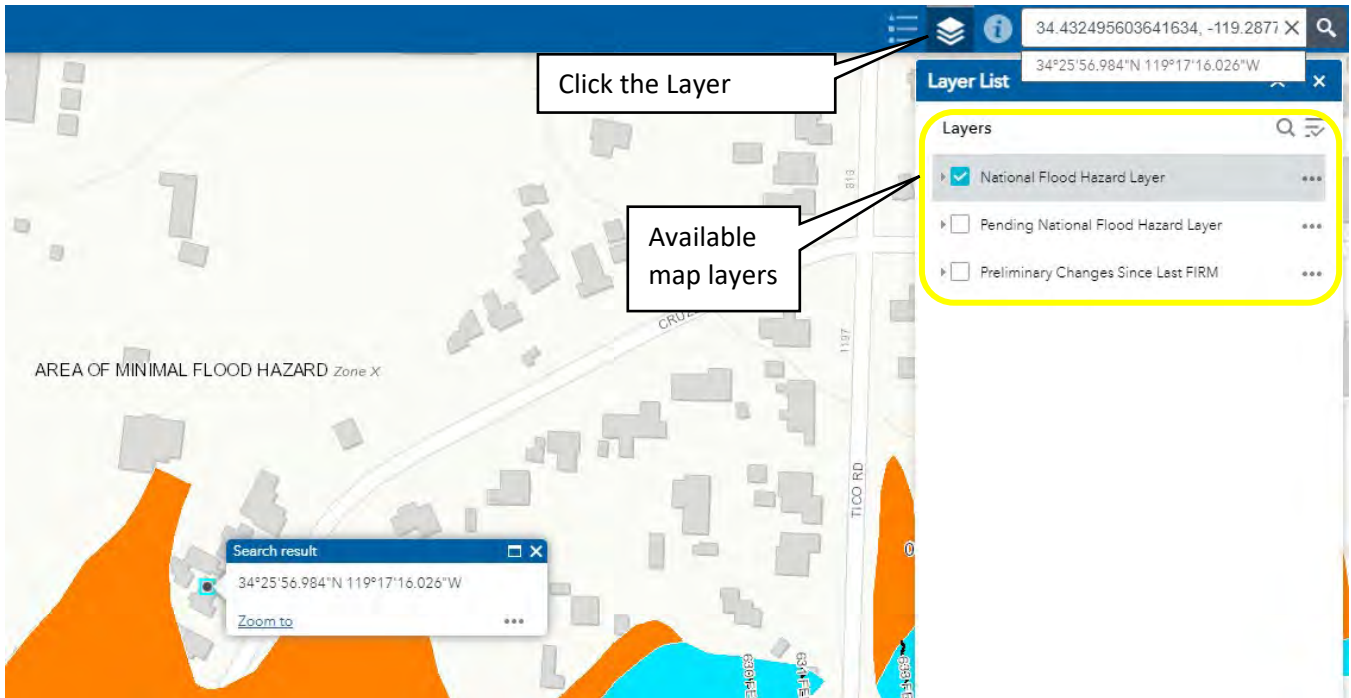
3. Click  after typing in the address.



4. Click the Legend button  to see a description of the shaded colors on the map.



5. Click on the Layer button  to see the flood hazard information available.



**6. Uncheck “National Flood Hazard Layer” and Check “Pending National Flood Hazard Layer”.**

Click here to uncheck. This is the current flood mapping.

Click here to check. This is flood mapping that will be official on 1/29/2020.

This layer highlights the changes between the first two layers.

The map zones around the search area have changed to show the new information.

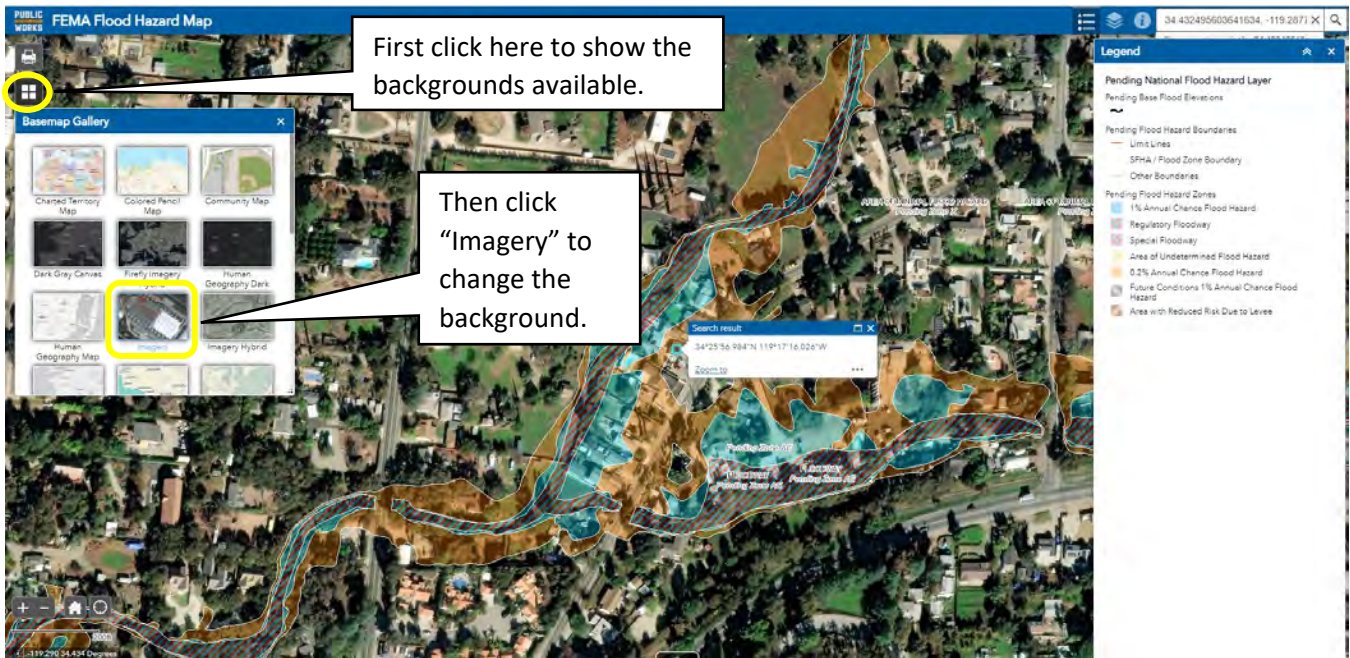
